The endowment in the name of the former Southern territorial commander and national commander was created by the friends of Andrew S. Miller. Commissioner Andrew S. Miller has served on the board of trustees of Asbury College for many years. His interest in Asbury goes back to his early years as a student. Later as a Divisional Youth Secretary stationed in Cincinnati, Ohio, he started what would become The Salvation Army Student Fellowship. Over the years Commissioner Miller has had an abiding interest in the Salvationist youth at Asbury. It is only fitting that this endowment be set up in his honor.

Recognizing the significant contribution to Salvation Army made by more than 500 Asbury Salvationists, with almost half this number being commissioned officers, the Miller Scholarship is intended to provide a leadership training program and financial assistance for Salvationist youth of USA South to attend Asbury College.

### HISTORY

Instituted in 1998 by the vision of Territorial Commander Commissioner John Busby, this scholarship recognizes the contributions of Willouise Luce and Charles I. Babcock who co-chaired the scholarship fundraising campaign.

### ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be soldiers in good standing from the USA South who are accepted as students at Asbury College and who are willing to commit their lives to providing leadership in The Salvation Army as local officers or applying to enter the College for Officers Training. The student must also regularly attend a local corps while at Asbury University. Lectureship requirements include attendance and submission of a report on each lecture that includes how that lecture added to the student's knowledge of Army ministry and furthered their leadership development for local officership and/or officership. Applications must be submitted each semester. Students must maintain a "C" average for the previous semester or an overall "2.0" grade-point average. A hand written thank you note to the donors must be received before further applications are approved.

### PROCESS

- 1) The student submits a completed application and a copy of their prior semester transcripts to the Asbury Financial Aid office.
- 2) The Southern Territorial Headquarters The School for Leadership and Educational Development receives documents from Asbury with the unmet financial need of the student.
- 3) The Education Secretary confirms with local Salvation Army Officers the attendance and involvement in a Corps.
- 4) The Territorial Education Council reviews each application and recommends an action to the Board of Trustees.
- 5) If approved, a check in the amount up to \$5,000 will be sent to the address provided. Processing will take 6-8 weeks.
- 6) Upon receipt of the check, the student writes a hand written thank you note to the Donors and sends it to The School for Leadership and Educational Development.
- 7) Further approval will be contingent on the receipt of grades, lecture report, and thank you note.

### AMOUNT

Asbury College students who meet the eligibility requirements will receive a scholarship grant up to \$5,000 per year. If a student withdraws in time for Asbury's established proportioned refund on tuition, Asbury will consider an equal and proportioned refund to scholarship fund (not to the student) of that semester's scholarship grant.

### LECTURESHIP

The Lectureship requirement will serve the Salvationist family at Asbury College in the development of spiritual character, service competency and mission commitment. The guidelines for the lectureship are as follows:

Attendance at each lectureship

Submitting a report to The School for Leadership and Educational Development department with the following instructions:

- a Date, title, and thrust of lecture
- b A minimum of 150 words
- c Name and credits/position of lecturer
- d Include how the lecture added to the student's knowledge of Army mission and furthered their leadership development for local officership and/or officership
- e Due within three weeks after lecture

## DIRECT DEPOSIT ENROLLMENT/CHANGE FORM

The Salvation Army will electronically deposit your payments into your bank or credit union. (If direct deposit setup is not complete, the first payment will be by check sent through the US Mail.) The Territorial Finance Department will notify you via email when payment has been issued. The direct deposit system normally settles into your account in 1 or 2 business days after issuance.

1. Complete the information in boxes A, B, and C below to enroll in or change your direct deposit.
2. Enclose a voided check, if available.
3. Sign and date here: I authorize The Salvation Army to deposit payments to my account at the depository institution listed below. I authorize The Salvation Army to debit my account only for the purpose of correcting an amount erroneously credited to my account. I understand it is my responsibility to verify that payments issued by The Salvation Army have been credited to my account before attempting to draw on the funds. I understand that this authorization will remain in effect until I change my account number and notify The Salvation Army Territorial Finance Department in writing by completing a Direct Deposit Enrollment/Change Form.

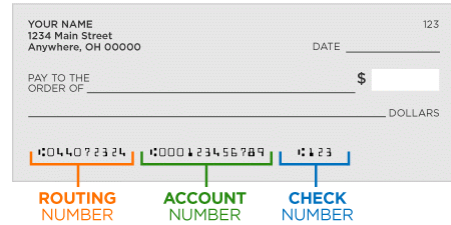
